Summary: The University of Vermont is located in the northwestern portion of the state, about 40 miles south of the Canadian border and adjacent to Lake Champlain. The school is called UVM for Universitas Viridis Montis (Latin for "University of the Green Mountains) and is the 5th oldest school in New England (after Harvard, Yale, Dartmouth, and Brown). About 35% of the students are Vermont residents. The school is known for its environmental concerns and strong academics.
