

Church Planting Profile:

Londonderry, New Hampshire

Summary: Londonderry is located in Rockingham County, about 10 miles north of the Massachusetts border and 20 miles southeast of Manchester. Londonderry is a very affluent community with a median household income nearly 50% higher than the state average. The population is white and relatively young with a large number of families with children at home. Evangelical Christians make up less than 2% of the population of Rockingham County. There is a PCA church and an OPC church in Manchester, as well as a PCA church in Nashua (10 miles southwest of Londonderry).
