

2010 Church Planting Profile:

Brunswick, Maine

Summary: Brunswick is located in Cumberland County, on the banks of the Kennebec River near the Atlantic Ocean. It is about 30 miles northeast of Portland on the mid-coast of Maine. Brunswick is the home of [Bowdoin College](#), a nationally-renowned liberal arts college, and has a highly-educated population. It is also home to the Brunswick Naval Air Station (closing in 2011 to be converted into a civilian airport and business park). The population is generally white, relatively young, and moderately affluent. Evangelical Christians make up about 4% of the population of Cumberland County. There is an OPC church meeting in Brunswick, a [PCA church](#) and an [OPC church](#) located in Portland, and a [PCA church](#) in Lewiston (20 miles northwest of Brunswick).
