

# 2010 Church Planting Profile: **Burlington, Vermont**

**Summary:** Burlington is the educational and cultural center of Vermont and the state's largest city. Its population is white, young, educated, and leans strongly to the left politically. As a whole, the people of the state of Vermont are last in the United States in "regular" church attendance (tied with New Hampshire). The church in Burlington largely reflects the cultural and political character of the city. Northern New England Presbytery is currently taking steps to begin a joint church planting/RUF work in Burlington. There is a [reformed church](#) in Williston and a [PCA church](#) in St. Albans (30 mi. N).
